

Survey Law 2

The overall purpose of *Survey Law 2* is to build on the foundation laid out in the <u>prerequisite</u>¹ course: <u>Survey Law 1</u>, with a special emphasis on evaluation of evidence and special circumstances encountered in problematic and natural boundaries. Understanding the workings of the legal system and the legal process is essential for regulated professionals entrusted to make ethical and defensible opinions that have the potential of being reviewed by a court.

Just like in *Survey Law 1*, there will be 2 online lectures per week: a "live" one on Wednesday evenings from 6 pm to 7:30 pm EST and a pre-recorded one later in the week.
